## **Environmental Sustainability Policy**

Causeway is committed to managing the impact of its activities on the environment. We aim to reduce our environmental impact per employee year-on-year.

To enable us to achieve this, Causeway has introduced an Environmental Management System (EMS), which includes the regular management review of key carbon measures, the recording of our carbon footprint and carbon offsetting.

## **Objectives**

Causeway is a carbon neutral company and we offset our calculated carbon footprint. All employees are involved in selecting the projects that we support.
